

Village Pastors Training Clusters in Photos



Rural pastors' training cluster session held in Zingbor Town, western Liberia in late September. This cluster contains five pastors from five remote regions who come together every two months for one week of pastoral training during the dry season. The Zingbor Town cluster usually starts in November, but we took advantage of the early sunshine in September to begin. There will be at least 3 more training meetings for them before the heavy rains come in May next year. Above (left): I am in photo (3rd from left) with the five pastors in the cluster. The photo on the right (above) shows the last day of the session; we were joined by other believers in a worship service. January is our next cluster training. There are 8 pastors' training clusters established in rural parts of Liberia.



The second training cluster (Bomi cluster) is the largest so far and contains 18 pastors. We conducted their first week-long session in mid-October in Tubmanburg, Bomi. The photo on the left (above) shows one of the training sessions with me facilitating (standing before the class), while the photo on the right is a group photo of participants. January 2020 is our next cluster training for the Bomi region.
