

Medical Outreach Ministry Update

On July 21-22, 2023, the ECOL Medical Outreach team conducted a mobile clinic in the predominantly Muslim village of Gbarma in Gbarpolu County, western Liberia. The team included 25 volunteers from SIM, ELWA, MAF and the Evangelical church of Liberia. On the team were five medical doctors, a wound specialist, an ophthalmologist, a midwife, 6 registered nurses, two pastors and 9 others who served as evangelists and counselors.



A total of 731 people were served and 34 people (all adults - 26 females and 8 males) received the Lord Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour - 29 on the first day, and 5 on the second day. 14 of the converts had been Muslims prior to their conversion. It is unprecedented to have such number of people come to faith in Christ in a predominantly Muslim community. We have introduced the converts to our church in Gbarma for fellowship and discipleship.



A missionary family, the Walkers, added a introduced new feature to the medical ministry. While the mobile clinic was in progress, Warwick, Lauren and their two daughters had time to minister to kids who were not ill but had come out of curiosity. The Walkers told Bible stories and played games with the kids.
